1. 80th Avenue Speed Feedback Signs

The city has received numerous complaints about the high speeds and the limited sight distance on 80th Avenue. Much of 80th Avenue will be improved when property owners develop. In the meantime, the installation of speed feedback signs will provide an interim improvement that will help slow vehicles down.

2. 276th Street TIB Grant

The city was successful in obtaining grant funding from the TIB for paving 276th Street from 73rd Avenue to east city limits. These grants are for 90% of the costs, requiring a 10% match by the city. The total grant funding is \$264,379, and the 10% match will be \$26,438. The matching funds will come from the Transportation Benefit District (TBD). This project is in the City's 2021 budget and Capital Improvement Plan. Along with the paving, approximately 6 ADA ramps will be brought up to current standards.
