**1. On-Call Electrical Contracts**

Informational:

From time to time the City has a need to complete work using a licensed electrician. Without one on staff the need to hire an outside person or firm becomes necessary. With a lot of the needs for electrical work time is of the essence due to a component or components of a system not working. Having an electrician on call gives staff the flexibility to get a person(s) to remedy a problem quickly. An RFP was issued using the MRSC roster. The City received three bids. Staff selected Bonner Electrical Contracting, LLC and Control Dynamics, Inc. based on rates, response time and type(s) of licenses.

**2. IS4 Phase 3 Project – PACE Engineers Task Order**

Informational:

City Administrator to sign a task order with PACE Engineers for the design of the Irvine Slough Stormwater Separation Phase 3 project for \$65,000. This will provide design for phase 3, which consists of the conveyance to the new pump at the Irvine Slough Lift Station. The conveyance will go under SR 532 and connect a portion of downtown to the new pump.

**3. SR 532 Berm Project Update**

Informational:

The berm is project is getting very close. The mitigation planting below the berm was completed last week. The remaining items include a small amount of paving at the east end, installation of the bench, and some cleanup. Staff has requested a quote for the landscaping along the north side of the berm but has yet to receive it.

**4. Pioneer Highway Sewer Project Update**

Informational:

The pioneer Highway sewer upgrade project was advertised for bids on Monday 1/25. The bid opening is scheduled for Thursday 2/11. Staff would like to bring the lowest responsible bid to full council on February 25, versus waiting until after the March PW committee meeting. This project will upsize the sewer from the Fox Hill development to the viaduct.
