**1. New Public Works Employee**

We are pleased to announce Eric Hentila will join the City effective February 25, 2021 as *Public Works Supervisor in the Streets, Parks, Drainage and Buildings and Grounds Division*. Mr. Hentila comes to us with more than 20 years of municipal maintenance and operations leadership experience from the City of Arlington, with the majority of those years overseeing streets, parks, storm drainage, facilities and cemetery maintenance, and in excess of 30 years of equipment operating experience. Most recently, Eric served as Arlington's Maintenance & Operations Crew Chief and currently holds professional licenses and certifications as MUTCD Signs and Markings Specialist, Erosion and Sediment Control Lead, Confined Space Entry, Work Zone Safety, Fall Protection, CDL Class A with Tanker Endorsement, Washington State Flagger, First Aid/CPR, and several supervisory and management training certifications.

**2. Speed Feedback Sign Update**

Speed feedback signs are being installed on 80<sup>th</sup> Ave between 280<sup>th</sup> and 284<sup>th</sup> and will be fully operational the week of March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**3. Copper Station No Parking Signs**

A letter and information were sent to Adam Miller the HOA president explaining that No Parking signs will be installed in the development.

**4. Pioneer Highway Sewer Phase 2: Bids**

BHC Engineering completed the design of the sewer line on Pioneer Hwy, from Fox Hill to the viaduct. This section of sewer is exceeding its capacity and needs to be upsized. Staff advertised for bids in January and opened them on February 11<sup>th</sup>. We received 13 bids ranging from \$945,250.49 to \$1,872,206.70; engineer's estimate was \$1,529,329.62. The low responsive and responsible bidder is Pellco Construction with a bid amount of \$945,250.49.
