ISSUE

The purpose of this agenda item is to discuss the creation of a Police Chief's Community Advisory Board.

SUMMARY

The Stanwood Police Department continues to look for ways to engage and connect with our community. The Chief's Community Advisory Board would consist of a diverse group of residents, business owners, faith-based leaders and educators. Board members would meet with the Police Chief on a regular basis to discuss a variety of topics relating to police services and how to address priorities in the community.

DISCUSSION

The intent of the program is to leverage the knowledge and perspectives of the board members to enhance how Stanwood Police engages and interacts with the community. Conversely, members will become more knowledgeable about law enforcement in their community. Board members would be invited to participate in official department events, assist with community outreach, and assist the Chief with promoting public trust.

- Serve as a resource to the Chief in understanding and responding to public safety issues facing the police department and community.
- Act as a sounding board for the Chief regarding proposed police programs and priorities.
- Promote public awareness of police services and programs
- Occasionally serve as panelists during Stanwood Police testing processes.

The board would consist of 6 to 8 individuals who reside, work or attend school in the City of Stanwood. Selection would be made by the Chief of Police and members would serve 2-year terms.
