Item 5 – PROS Plan Outline Review

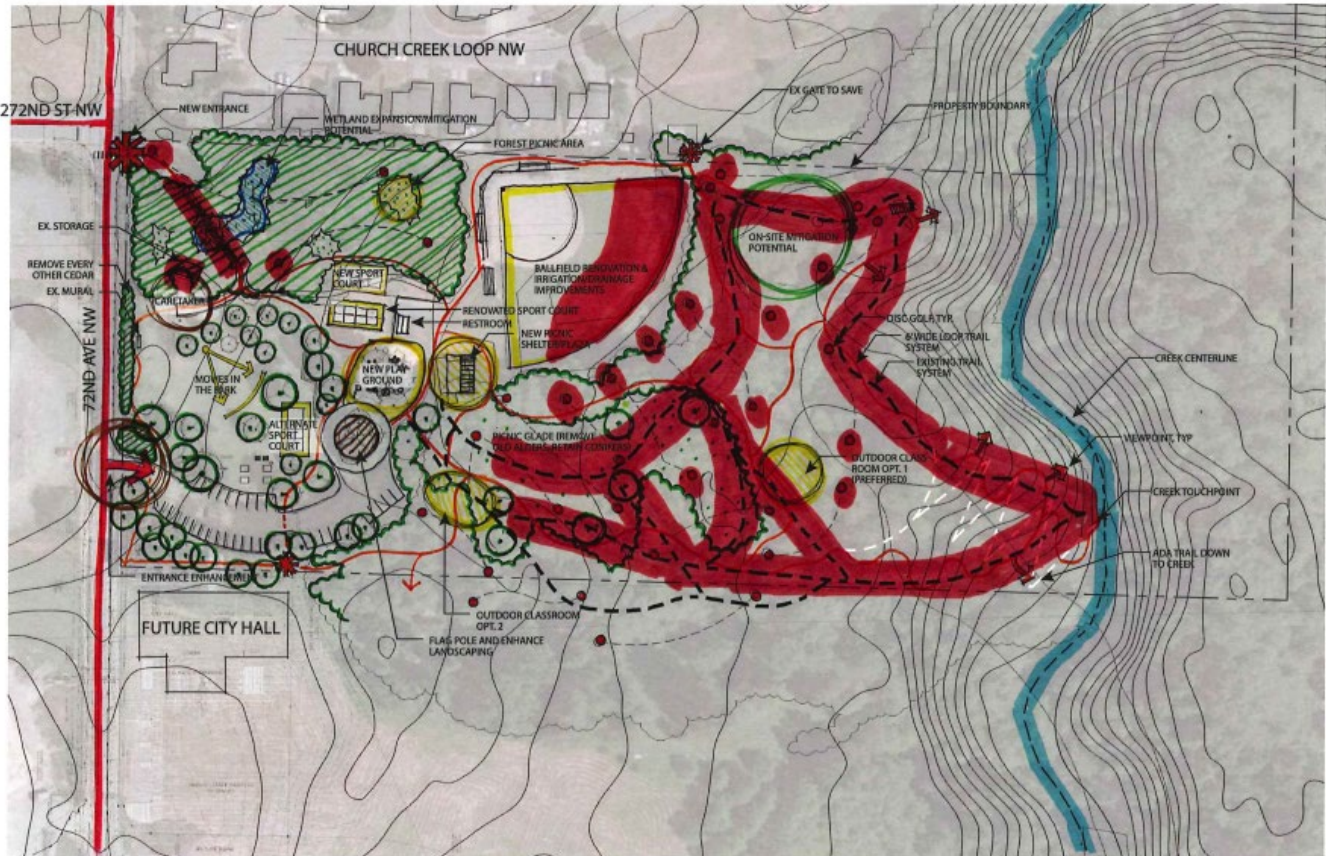
City Planning Staff will provide suggested edits to parks/trails related Comprehensive Plan goals and policies for PTAC review at the meeting.

Item 7 – Church Creek Park Critical Areas Review

The graphic below depicts existing impacts to current wetland/stream buffers at Church Creek Park.



The following is a timeline of Church Creek Park Development and regulation:

- 1971: City purchases Church Creek Park property
- 1972: City receives state and/or federal grant to develop Church Creek Park
- 1973: City begins to develop Church Creek Park
- 1974: 1890's era cabin moved to park site
- 1985/86: Baseball field constructed
- 1994: State adopts CAO
- 2004: City adopts CAO (may have been earlier, but this is what I was able to find)
- 2015: Disc golf constructed
- 2019: Disc golf expanded
