**ORDINANCE No. 1256**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD LEVYING TAXES FOR  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UPON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO  
TAXATION WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF  
STANWOOD, WASHINGTON FOR THE YEAR 2010.**

**WHEREAS**, the electorate of the City has previously voted to tax itself for emergency medical services; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Stanwood has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2010; and,

**WHEREAS**, the city's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$279,708; and,

**WHEREAS**, the population of the city is less than 10,000; and now, therefore,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DO ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:** That an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2010 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$2,797 which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
