ORDINANCE 1392

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD,
WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE CITY WATER
UTILITY; REPEALING RESOLUTION 2010-08 ADOPTING
THE 2010 COMPREHENSIVE WATER SYSTEM PLAN;
AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF STANWOOD'S 2015
COMPREHENSIVE WATER SYSTEM PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Stanwood owns and operates a water supply system which in 2013, the City provided water service to an average of 2,554 connections. Approximately 2,151 connections (84%) were single-family residential customers, 68 connections (3%) were multi-family residential customers, and 335 connections (13%) were all other customer types. The 68 multi-family residential connections serve approximately 748 units (units represent individual apartments, condominiums, or other components of a multi-family dwelling); and

WHEREAS, the Water Utility provides the entire domestic service for all residential and commercial customers in the City and residential and commercial customers in parts of unincorporated Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, all water purveyors located within a Critical Water Supply Service Area (CWSSA) are required to have a water service area agreement that identifies the external boundary of their water service area. North Snohomish County was declared a CWSSA on October 19, 1988. The City prepared and signed a water service area agreement during the development of the North Snohomish County Coordinated Water System Plan, which was finalized in 1991; and

WHEREAS, under Department of Health regulations, the City is to update its water system plan every six years in accordance with WAC 246.290.100. The City has commissioned the preparation by RH2, working with the City, of a draft update to the City of Stanwood Comprehensive Water System Plan. The Draft Plan was submitted to the Department of Health for review on March 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City's Determination of Non-Significance on the Comprehensive Water System Plan, pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act was issued on March 3, 2015 and no appeals were filed; and

WHEREAS, the City published the public hearing notice on March 3, 2015 in the Stanwood / Camano News for the Comprehensive Water System Plan; and

WHEREAS, following written and mailed notice, the City conducted a public hearing on the City of Stanwood 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan for Water Utility customers and others on March 26, 2015; and

WHEREAS, no Water Utility customer or members of the audience provide comments during this public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City published a second public hearing notice on March 24, 2015 in the Stanwood / Camano News for the Water Use Efficiency Goals; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in a second public hearing on April 9, 2015 considered the Water Use Efficiency Goals, allowing the public to provide both written and oral comments on the goals; and

WHEREAS, no Water Utility customer or members of the audience provide comments during this second public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, having considered the 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan and any comment thereon, determines it appropriate to adopt the Plan for this six year planning period and the requirements of Washington law, and serves and advances public health, safety and welfare of the Water Customer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2010-08 the City adopted the 2010 Comprehensive Water System Plan which will be replaced by adoption of the 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal and adoption. Resolution 2010-08 adopting the City of Stanwood 2010 Comprehensive Water System Plan, supporting appendices and any approved amendments is hereby repealed. The City of Stanwood hereby adopts the City of Stanwood 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan a copy of which is attached hereto.

Section 2. Final Plan. Copies of the City of Stanwood 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan approved by the City Council shall be available for public review at the office of the City Clerk following final approval by the Department of Health (Health). The Final Plan shall include as necessary all grammatical and number revisions and any necessary revisions as identified by Health.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance of Plan adopted herein, or their application to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remainder of any part of this Ordinance or Plan. To this end, provisions of each clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Ordinance and Plan are declared severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on the date on which the Department of Health approves in writing the City of Stanwood 2015 Comprehensive Water System Plan, which date is more than five days following publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof. If Health does not approve the Plan in its entirety,

then those portions approved by Health shall be effective, and the portions not approved by Health shall not be included in this adoption.


