ORDINANCE 1464

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON,
LEVYING TAXES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UPON ALL
PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD, WASHINGTON FOR 2019**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stanwood properly gave notice and conducted a public hearing pursuant to RCW 84.55.120 on October 25, 2018 to consider the current expense budget and property tax levies for 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the electorate of the City has previously voted to tax itself for emergency medical services; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stanwood has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the city's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$386,804.40; and,

WHEREAS, the population of the city is less than 10,000;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANWOOD DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

That an increase in the regular property tax levy for emergency medical services is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2019 tax year.


The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$3,869 which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
