STANWOOD – Stanwood Clean Sweep Postponed

The city of Stanwood and WM have postponed the Clean Sweep drop-off event scheduled for Saturday, May 14, due to capacity issues at two Snohomish County transfer stations.

Snohomish County notified the city this week about capacity constraints at the Airport Road Recycling and Transfer Station in Everett and the Southwest Recycling and Transfer Station in Mountlake Terrace. Communications from the county indicated equipment and staff shortages have slowed the facilities' ability to accept and reload waste to be transported for disposal.

WM and Stanwood have not identified a new date for the event.
